COURSES



BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (B. Sc.) IN NURSING

Basic B.Sc. Nursing course comprises of 4 years duration. This program of study leads to a B.Sc. Nursing Degree offered by the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nasik.

Seats - 40 Duration: - 4 Years

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

The minimum age for the admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought

 12^{th} Science PCB group with minimum 45% marks (135) for open category and 40% mark (120) for reserved category (SC, ST, VJNT, OBC)

MH-BSc Nursing CET Eligibility for Admission to BSc Nursing Course

1. A candidate belonging to open category and EWS category must score not less than 50% marks in MH.BSc Nursing -CET

2. A candidate belonging to constitutional Reservation and constitutional Reservation for person with disability claim must secure no less than 40% marks in MH .BSc Nursing -CET



GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY (GNM)

The Diploma Nursing course comprises of 3 years duration which includes Midwifery. Examination is taken at the end of each year for the internship after which the students are eligible to get registration from Maharashtra Nursing Council. Mumbai.

Seats - 60 Duration: - 3 Years





ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

The minimum age for the admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.

The maximum age of admission shall be 35 years.

The minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 preferably science (PCB) and English with aggregate of 45%.

Student should be medically fit.



AUXILIARY NURSE MIDWIFERY (A.N.M.)

The Diploma Nursing course comprises of 2 years duration which includes Midwifery. Examination is taken at the end of each year for the internship after which the students are eligible to get registration from Maharashtra Nursing Council. Mumbai.

Seats - 40 Duration: - 2 Years

ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

The minimum age for the admission shall be 17 years on or before 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.

The maximum age of admission shall be 35 years.

The minimum educational requirement shall be 10+2 arts and English with aggregate of 45%.

Student should be medically fit.
